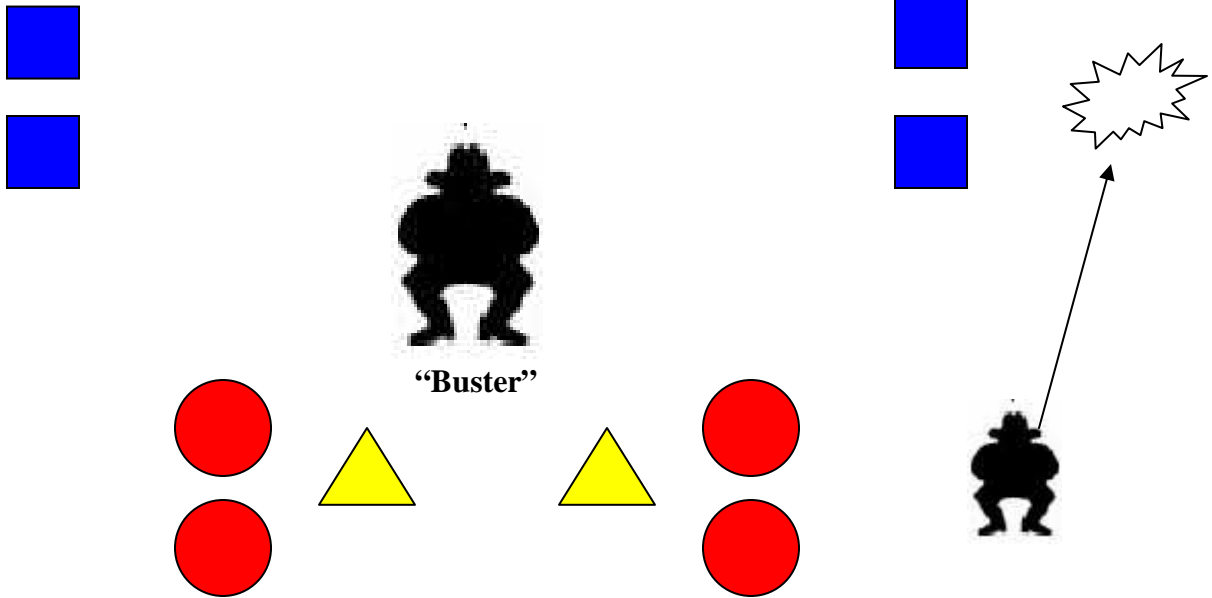


“Buster is a Tough Ole Bird!”

Stage 4

10 Pistol, 10 Rifle and 4 Shotgun



Pony

Story: That Buster is a tough one! He and a few of his gang escape your attack. The next day, you are tracking them into the hills when the hair stands up on the back of your neck and you know something is wrong. Before you can complete the thought, Buster hollers “Stick ‘em Up!” and you comply. Buster tells you that he’s going to string you up for killing his friends. You think, “Die Swinging?” or “Die Shooting?” The choice is easy! You go for your guns!

You will need: Two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each with hammer down over empty chambers in your holsters. A shotgun, empty with action open on the pony, with at least 4 rounds on your person. A rifle loaded with 10 rounds on the pony.

Directions: (the “Buster” target is both a rifle and pistol target) Start standing at the pony with both hands head high in the surrender position. When ready, say “I’m no swinger!”

At the Signal: Draw your pistols and, per your shooting style, engage the pistol targets in this order, shoot Buster first, then a target on the left, Buster, other target on the left, Buster, a target on the right, Buster, the other target on the right, Buster, then Buster again! Holster, and..

Pick up the rifle and engage the rifle targets in the same manner as the pistol targets. Set the rifle on the pony and...

Pick up your **shotgun** and knock down the three shotgun targets and engage the aerial bird. You must engage the bird and you get a 5 second bonus for breaking it in the air.

Take your firearms to the unloading table.
